Prevention + Rejuvenation = **Pre-Juvenation**

As we all want to age gracefully, medical science has provided new techniques to prevent wrinkles and help us Pre-Juvenate. Read more about how this works...

Wrinkle prevention is a series of small injections of relaxing solutions like Dysport or Botox, into individual muscles in your areas of concern (areas containing wrinkles), preventing them from forming unnecessary and undesirable facial expression and further creasing and damaging of the skin.

What does Dysport/Botox do?

Wrinkle prevention injections will not radically change your appearance or 'freeze' your facial expressions – they just soften the areas of concern and make you appear younger and more refreshed. By maintaining your injections, however, we are preventing the onset of future wrinkles.

What causes wrinkles?

Wrinkles are simply lines and creases. They are caused by a number of factors including heredity, ageing (due to the depletion of collagen and elastin), facial expressions, smoking, general lifestyle habits (such as high sun exposure) and excessive squinting while using computers, tablets or phones.

When we are young and our skin is strong and elastic, 'expression wrinkles' disappear when we relax our muscles. However, as we age and continually contract our facial muscles, we establish permanent facial lines.

Are wrinkle prevention injections safe?

Yes. Dysport and Botox are very safe. Dysport and Botox have been used by doctors for more than 20 years on millions of people around the world and it is one of the most studied and researched medical procedures proving to have no long-term side effects.

What happens during the procedure?

Wrinkle prevention injections are carefully placed in the muscles that are causing the skin to wrinkle. This deactivates a protein in the nerve endings that makes a nerve-transmitter chemical that allows the muscles to work. This, in turn, prevents the nerves from moving the muscle, therefore smoothing the overlying skin.

How long does the procedure take?

The actual injection time is only 10-15 minutes. We offer a <u>free consultation</u> that takes 20-30minutes to fully inform you of all the details and expected results and possible side-effects. The choice of using Dysport of Botox will be determined and discussed during your consultation.

Which areas can be treated?

- Crow's feet
- Glabellar Lines (in between eyebrows)
- Forehead

In addition to these popular areas above, wrinkle prevention injections can be used in many other areas to achieve the desirable effects without taking away from our normal natural expressions.

These include:

- 'Bunny smile lines' at the top of the nose;
- Reduction of 'gummy smile';
- Lift sagging at the side of the mouth;
- Improve chin creases and dimpling;
- Slim the lower face (Masseter muscles);
 Decrease hook at nose tip when smiling.

Are they painful?

No. The treatment is a quick and simple procedure that is relatively pain-free. Even those afraid of needles are surprised at the ease of treatment.

Is there any downtime?

No. Recovery is immediate. There may be some redness and faint marks from injections that usually disappear within a few minutes. Make-up can be reapplied immediately.

There may be slight bruising that can last for a few days, but easily covered up by make-up.

When will I start to see results?

You will start to see results within a few days but it takes 7-14 days to see the full results. It takes time for the targeted nerve endings to become 'deactivated'.

Will this treatment affect my muscles and nerves in the long-term?

No. It is only the proteins within the nerve endings that are affected.

Muscles that are treated are those that create undesirable facial expressions and we weaken them. Indeed, overtime with continual use of wrinkle prevention injections, these muscles become weaker. This is a desirable effect. It will eventually, over time, reduce the amount and frequency of treatments needed.

How long do the results last?

Usually 4-6 months. Over time (about 2-3 years), the results will last longer due to the nerve proteins becoming slower at rebuilding.

When should I begin having wrinkle prevention injections?

Ideally, wrinkle prevention injections should be considered in your late twenties or early thirties – before the signs of ageing begin to show and you develop permanent, deep lines on your face. This is because the injections prevent future wrinkles, helping you maintain a youthful appearance. But it is never too late to start and prevent further signs of ageing.

Can wrinkle prevention injections be combined with other procedures?

Yes. They are often used in combination with dermal fillers, especially where deep creases have already formed and need to be filled with complimentary products like Restylane.

Our laser skin repair and skin tightening treatments can also compliment and be combined with wrinkle prevention injections.

How much does it cost?

The cost of wrinkle prevention injections is determined by the number of units required to achieve your desired result.

Here at Rejuvenate Medical Spa, the regular price of Botox is \$12 per unit and Dysport is \$10 per unit

As each person is unique and their needs are varied, the true cost of each procedure can't be determined over the phone. We offer a <u>free consultation</u> and as your face is unique, you should have an individual assessment. This requires us to see you face to face, and to assess the strength of each muscle group to be treated. *

Tummy Tuck

A tummy tuck or abdominoplasty is tailored to your needs and the precise nature of the procedure will vary from client to client.

Abdominoplasty generally includes the removal of excess skin and fat from the lower abdomen and tightening of the abdominal wall musculature.

Some clients may benefit from more limited procedures such as a modified or mini-abdominoplasty or liposuction.

All abdominoplasty surgery will leave a scar on the lower abdomen, which may extend from hip to hip and an additional scar around the umbilicus. Scars will fade with time. An abdominal binder or other support garment should be worn for the first 3 weeks post-operatively. Most patients require an additional 2 to 6 weeks for full recovery.



What's the difference?

Dysport/Botox are purified proteins that are injected into the muscle. Botox and Dysport stop dynamic wrinkles in the injected area. Botox/Dysport are slow release substances, therefore it takes up to two weeks before you can see and feel its full effect. In most cases, Botox/Dysport are used in the upper third of the face for areas such as, frown lines, forehead lines and crows feet. While Botox-/Dysport may stop a muscle from contracting, (which creates smoother and relaxed looking skin) they don't smooth appearance of existing deep lines - this is where Filler is utilized.

Filler such as Restylane are a clear gel that contain Hyaluronic Acid. Restylane is also Dr. Elmaraghy's filler of choice at Rejuvenate Medical Spa. Hyaluronic acid naturally occurs in the body. It is a component of our skin, helping to maintain the skin's firmness, it contours our features and it provides lubrication in our joints. Hyaluronic acid attracts and binds to water (Holding 1000x its weight in water) which is the reason why it is used to add volume to those deeper lines and areas that need contouring. Clients see instant results and leave looking more youthful.

Chemical Peels

What is a Chemical Peel?

A chemical peel is a non-invasive skin treatment that assists in shedding dead skin cells from the face, neck, hands and other body parts. A chemical solution is applied to the skin, removing damaged layers, leaving new skin that is smoother and more youthful looking. When hearing the words 'chemical peel', numerous people instantly have a flashback to the scene from 'Sex and the City' when Samantha wears a face-covering hat to hide her red face. The vision of red, irritated, peeling and raw skin is ingrained in your mind, but most clients can resume regular activity shortly after a peel and experience very mild skin flaking for a few days.

Why Should You Get A Chemical Peel?




